I often hide in the bushes, avoiding towns. I work for people, especially politicians. I haven't settled in one place; I've been here for more than a month.

"I can hardly believe what is happening to me tonight. The only thing I remember is seeing an incident where one of Jesus Christ's disciples cut off a soldier's ear while they were arresting Jesus. To my astonishment, Jesus healed the soldier by putting his ear back. I couldn't comprehend how he could show such mercy to those who wanted to kill him. His words resonated with me, especially when he said, 'The one who fights with a sword shall die by the sword.'

"In that moment, I realised I had been wrong to commit all those evil acts in response to my parents' deaths. I shouldn't have sought vengeance against innocent people, and I am guilty of my sins. Please pray for me. I am uncertain if God will forgive me, but I promise to change my ways from this day forward. I could have lost my life in this process, but I want to believe that God wants me to serve Him.

"I have made up my mind to work for God until my death, and I believe it is no coincidence that God brought [the Jesus Film to my town]. May God bless you all. I am genuinely happy to become a changed person. I was lost, but now God has found me. Please pray for me, and may God's mercy and guardianship be with me as I embark on this new life with Christ.
